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Nautilus and Light Windowmanagers

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"Running Nautilus (Gnome Content Manager) or other application that needs D-Bus inside light windowmanagers like Fluxbox can become a problem. D-Bus supplies both a system daemon (for events such as ?new hardware device added? or ?printer queue changed?) and a per user login session daemon (for general IPC needs among user applications). Desktop managers such as KDE, Gnome and Xfce start D-Bus with their session manager, but Fluxbox and the light windowmanagers often do not provide any session manager and in this case D-Bus must be started by yourself."

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
