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Nginx vs Apache with APC and Varnish

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There are a lot of test and comparisons about Nginx vs Apache. And yes for static content because it is asynchronous, Nginx performs better. What happens when you have PHP?

I have setup two servers with:

- Apache + PHP + APC + Varnish
- Nginx + PHP-FPM + APC + Varnish

Adding APC and Varnish as stages and it seems that in those conditions both Apache and Nginx are almost the same thing.

Actually I used them to server Wordpress documents, so MySQL was also involved, but the bottle neck was PHP, APC made a great job and with Varnish both setups fly.
